Guilty Secret is a four character thriller.

Does he plan to double cross Lennie, frame him for the crime and keep all the money for himself? Will slow-witted Lennie work out what's going on in time to save himself?

Roger Mortimer-Smith was born in London. Along with *Guilty Secret*, he is also the author of *Why Don't You Sing Jazz? Trauma, The Telephone* and *The Ties That Bind*. His work has been translated into German, Italian, Spanish and Polish.

Sheila Tracy, writing in *The Stage* newspaper said of the first performance:

"It is rare indeed to find oneself totally committed to a play and mesmerised from the very first word. Total concentration from start to finish makes this first thriller by Roger Mortimer-Smith all the more remarkable. Add to that moments of sheer comedy, bringing roars of laughter, and you have something truly unique... guaranteed to hold audiences spellbound."

This will be only the second amateur performance of *Guilty Secret* since its release in 2011. It was performed by the Sedlescombe Players in January 2013.
